Allocation

☐ TAOP 2004-2006

28 304 465 €(ERDF)

4 years of implementation

about 7 mln € per year

☐ TAOP 2007-2013

516 700 000 €(ERDF)

9 years of implementation

about 57.4 mln € per year

over 18 times bigger than TAOP 04-06!

☐ **TAOP 2004-2006**

155 projects within the whole implementation period

value of the projects: ~27 885 000 € (99% of allocation)

average value of projects: 179 900 €

☐ **TAOP 2007-2013**

86 projects within the first 2 years of implementation

value of the projects: ~158 623 000 € (30% of allocation)

average value of projects: 1 844 000 €

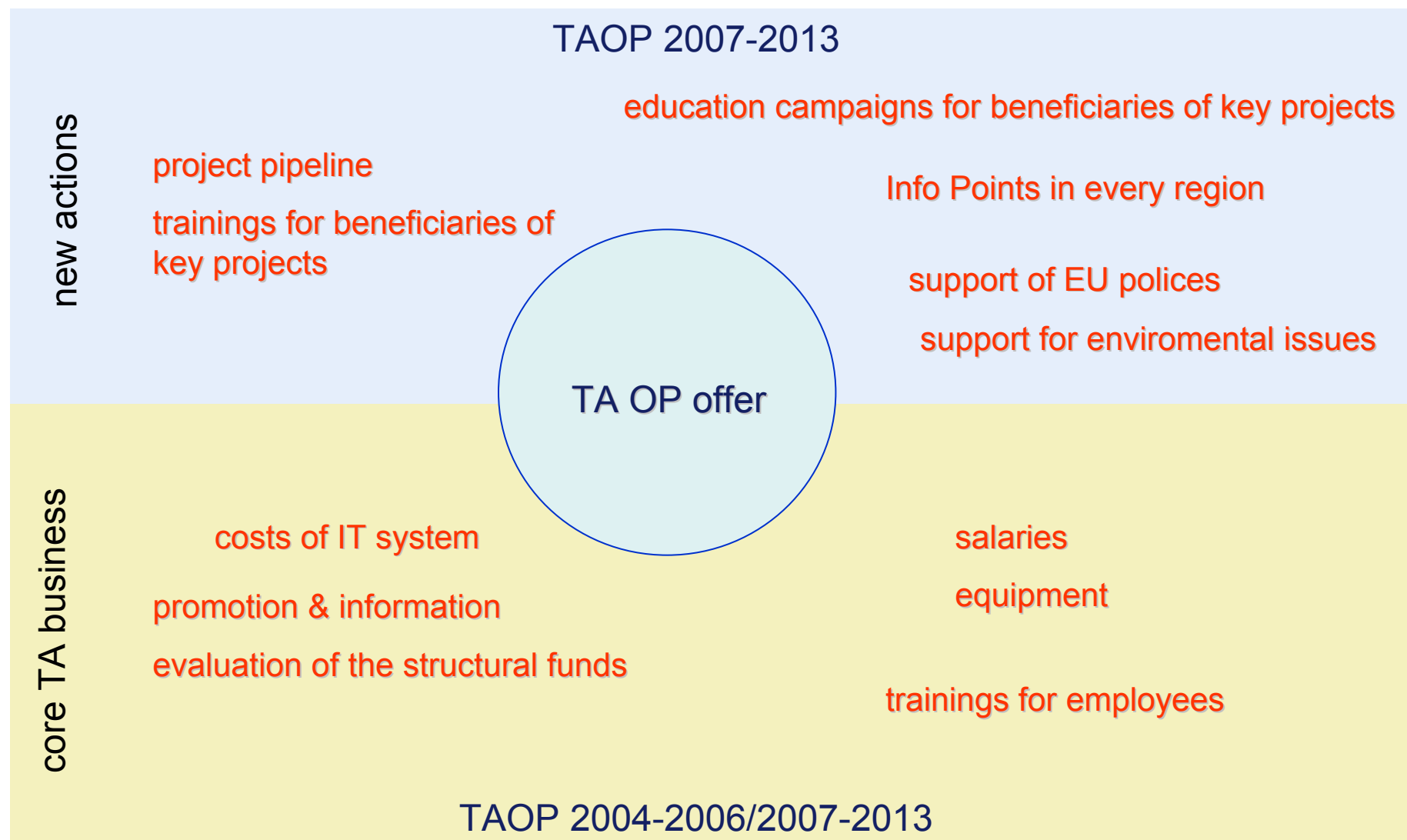

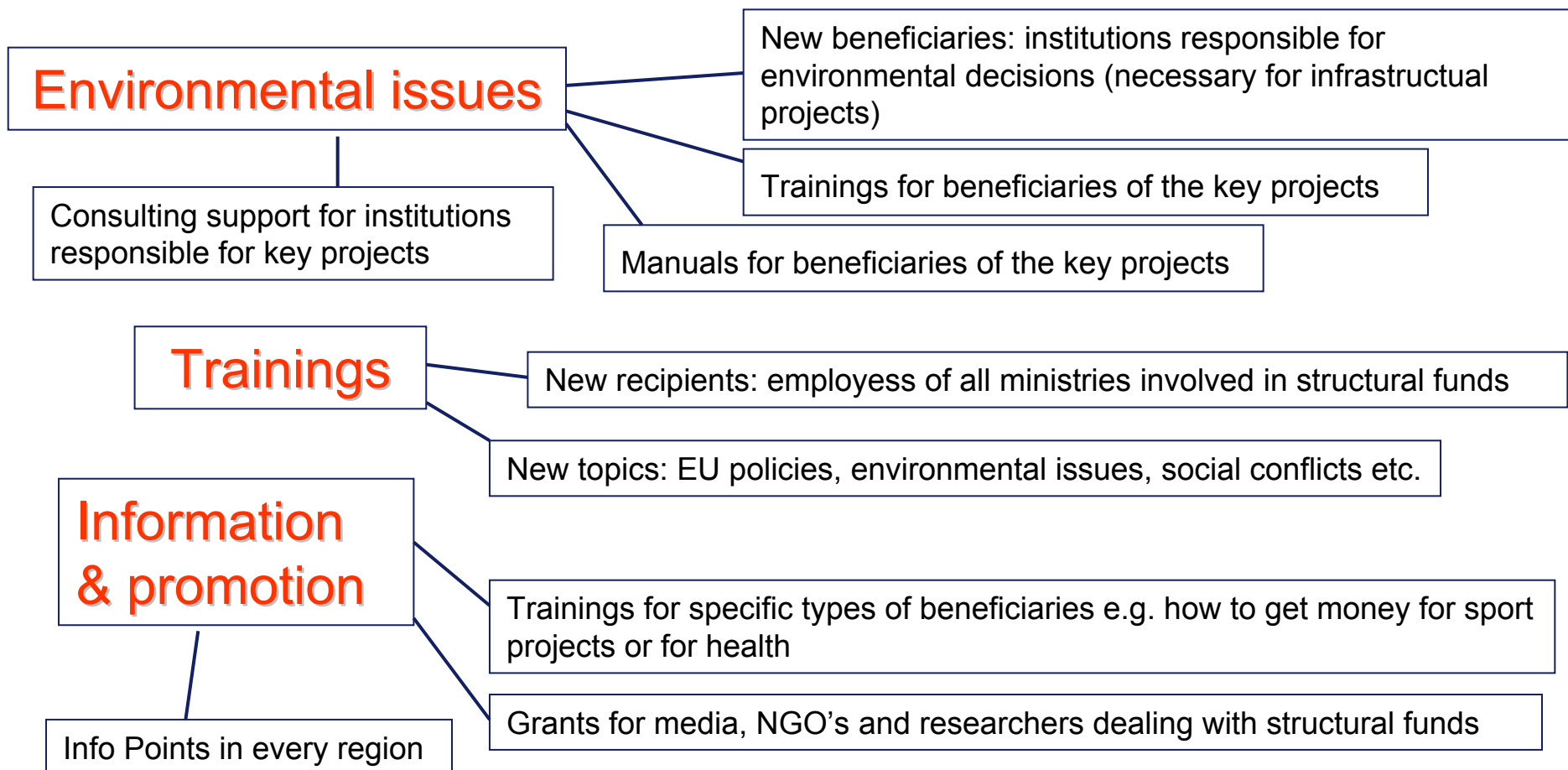

TAOP 2004-2006

small programme is much easier to co-ordinate

easier to contact and affect on beneficiaries

easier to control the programme

many small and too detailed projects

payments depend on one-two biggest beneficiaries

changes of structure of the ministry cause slowdown of payments and implementing of projects

TAOP 2007-2013

more diverse topic areas of the projects - we don't buy equipment only☺

complex support for institutions responsible for implementation of structural funds

common system of salaries for public administration responsible for implementation of structural funds

changes of administration structure don't pose a threat for payments

the Programme doesn't depend on one or two beneficiary

more formalised system of implementation

more detailed guidelines for beneficiaries

more beneficiaries to deal with



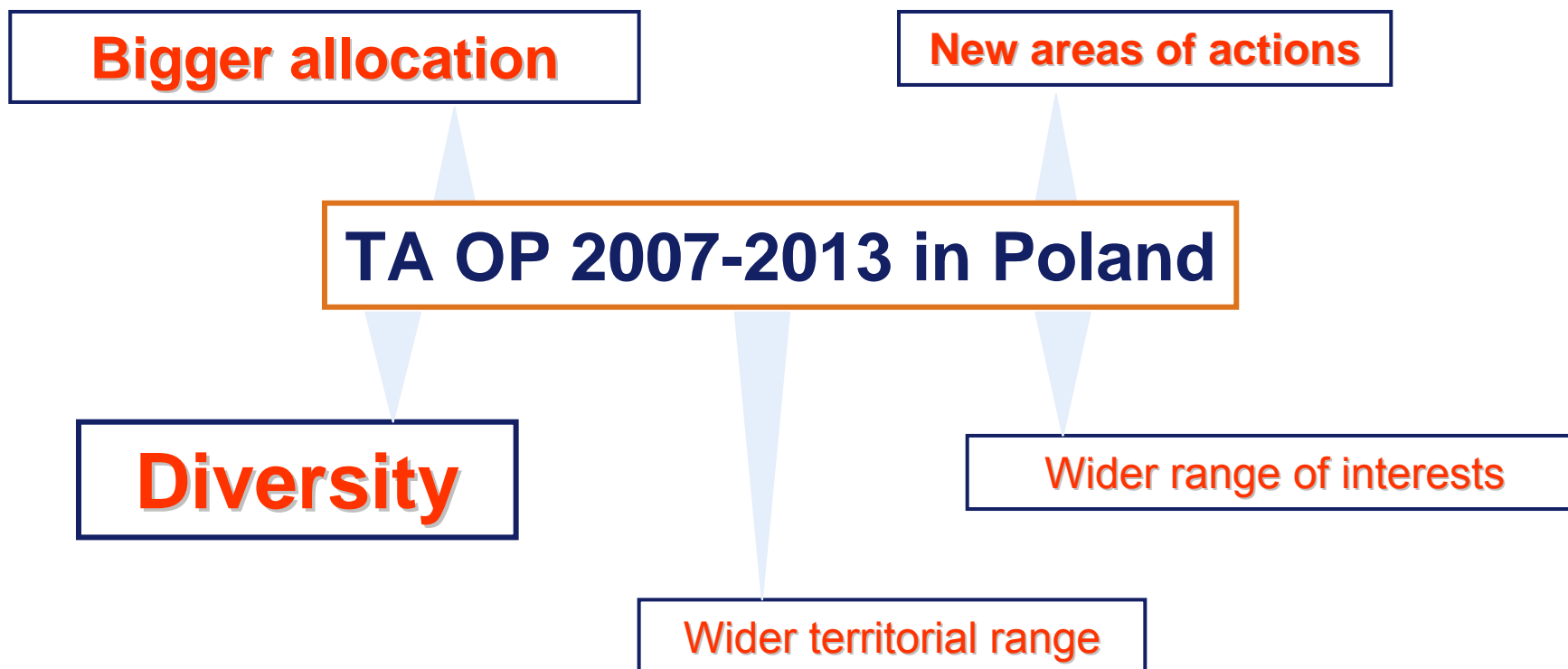

Tool kit for beneficiaries

all necessary documents, forms, instructions (both CD and paper version)

Meetings with beneficiaries

information meetings at least twice a year

Promotion & dissemination

organisation of Information Offices network (in every region in Poland at least one Info Point) → in co-operation with the local authorities

manuals for beneficiaries of the key projects ('Social conflicts in infrastructure investments' and '*Green* public procurements')

'promotion' grants for NGO's and media

trainings for specific types of potential beneficiaries (e.g. 'EURO for health', how to get money for sport projects etc.)

Salaries

common system of remuneration for all public administration responsible for implementation of structural funds

all Managing Authorities and Intermediate Bodies in ministries are beneficiaries of the TAOP

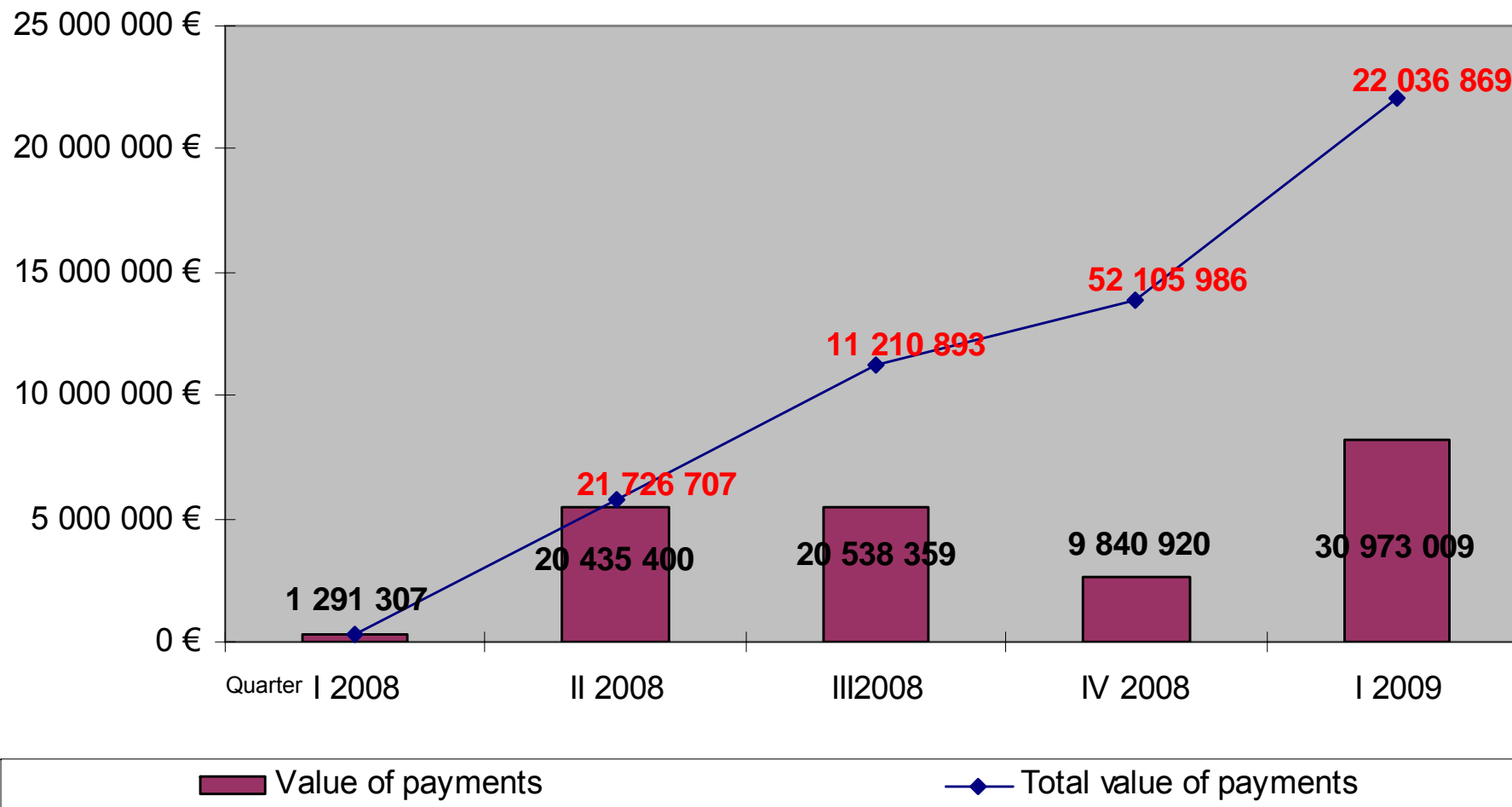
